Dear Parents,

Your child has the opportunity to receive additional academic services in our Title I funded after-school program for grades K-12. The afterschool program will run from 3:00-5:00 each day from March 1 through May 20. This is an important opportunity to help your child improve in school. By sending your child to the after-school program you are showing support and helping your child to be successful in the years to come.

The emphasis of the program will be on reading/math and homework assistance, with other enrichment opportunities. Students will receive a snack in the cafeteria directly after school. Students will then report to an academic classroom with a certified teacher. During this time they will have homework assistance and then work on either math or reading lessons to help them improve in that area. After the academic hour, if students have completed their homework they will receive enrichment lessons. If students have not completed their homework they will be required to attend the homework center.

If your student is interested in attending, please fill out the attached permission slip and send it back to your child's school office by Wednesday, February 24, 2016. Classes will begin on March 1 for students at North Greene Elementary and North Greene Jr. Sr. High. It is very important that you sign your child up as soon as possible so they do not miss any days. Transportation will be made available for students who are normally transported by bus, however if you wish to pick your student up before 5:00 p.m. you will be responsible for the transportation.
